## Roadmap to GRADUATION at South Texas College

<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>APPLICATION</b>	Complete an <b>Application</b> for Admission. Apply online at <a href="http://www.applytexas.org">www.applytexas.org</a> .
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>TRANSCRIPTS</b>	Provide <b>official transcripts</b> from your high school, or proof of GED completion (test scores or certificate) and any college transcripts.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>VACCINATION</b>	Contact your previous education institution(s) to request official transcripts. Transcripts may be delivered in person or mailed to the Office of Admissions and Records.
<b>1</b>		<b>Beginning January 2012</b> , all new students who did not attend STC in the Fall of 2011 will be <b>required to show proof of immunization against bacterial meningitis</b> . Please visit <a href="http://vaccinate.southtexascollege.edu">vaccinate.southtexascollege.edu</a> for more information.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>FINANCIAL AID</b>	Free cash, scholarships, work opportunities and emergency loans are available to eligible students. Complete the financial aid application online at <a href="http://www.fafsa.ed.gov">www.fafsa.ed.gov</a> , or in person at the financial aid office. School code: 031034.
<b>2</b>		Prospective students and parents may visit <a href="http://www.southtexascollege.edu/security/disclosure.html">http://www.southtexascollege.edu/security/disclosure.html</a> to view institutional reports and information regarding FERPA, campus safety and student success.
		<b>Students who are reported as not attending class are subject to reversal and/or cancellation of their financial aid award. You must attend all classes to retain your full award and to be eligible for your final refund.</b>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>ADVISING</b>	<b>Advisors</b> will assist you in identifying test requirements, managing your degree plan, and ensuring that you are aware of campus tools and resources that will assist you in becoming a successful student. Visit the advising center at a campus near you to plan your schedule and review your degree plan.
<b>3</b>		<b>You must fulfill the state-mandated assessment test requirements before completing the advisement process.</b>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>TESTING</b>	If you are required to take a state-mandated reading, writing and/or math <b>assessment test</b> (THEA or ACCUPLACER), please logon to the STC marketplace at <a href="https://secure.touchnet.com/C20193_ustores/web/">https://secure.touchnet.com/C20193_ustores/web/</a> , select a testing site/center and register for an exam.
<b>4</b>		<b>Once you have received your test scores, return to the Advising office to complete the advisement process and to prepare for registration.</b>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>REGISTRATION</b>	Use the <b>Advisement Form</b> to select courses from the current <b>STC course schedule</b> . You may register in person or online using the student portal – JagNet. <b>Username and PIN required for online registration</b> . You will not receive a registration confirmation. You should verify your schedule online, by phone or in person before classes start.

<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>ORIENTATION</b>	Complete the mandatory <b>New Student Orientation First Year Connection</b> .
<b>6</b>		New Student Orientations are held before each semester. Visit the Welcome Center, or logon to <a href="http://studentservices.southtexascollege.edu/studentlife/registration.html">http://studentservices.southtexascollege.edu/studentlife/registration.html</a> for the orientation schedule.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>TUITION &amp; FEES</b>	<b>Pay tuition and fees</b> . Enrollment is complete only upon full payment of tuition and fees, financial aid award or approved installment plan. Tuition must be <b>paid in full by the due date or you risk being dropped</b> from your classes. Financial Aid awards are posted to your account on or before the tuition due date. Continue to check <b>JagNet</b> for the most current information regarding your financial aid status. Emergency loans are subject to availability.

<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>BOOKS</b>	<b>Buy your books</b> . You may buy your books at the campus bookstore. The bookstore may have used books for sale which can save you money.

<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>GO TO CLASS</b>	Be in class, not in line the first class day. <b>Attendance is mandatory for students receiving financial aid</b> . You must be attending class to be eligible for your final refund.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>STUDENT LIFE</b>	<b>Check out Student Life!</b> Get connected and meet people through intramural sports, activities, cultural events, clubs, Student Government, volunteer and leadership opportunities.

<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>GRADUATE</b>	<b>Stay on track for graduation!</b> Make sure that you take courses in your degree plan – it is your roadmap to graduation. If you have questions about your degree plan, changing your major, or planning your schedule please visit an Advising office at a campus near you.
