4. ___ Apply for financial aid and scholarships.

6. ___ Books will not be held beyond designated dates unless, student makes special arrangements with Advising Specialist/Advisor.
7. ___ If enrolled in a developmental course, participants must submit a progress report as assigned by Advising Specialist/Advisor.
