



Gloria Fitch Scholarship Guidelines

The following are the guidelines for the administration of the Gloria Fitch Scholarship unless otherwise amended by the office of Student Financial Services or the donor.

Scholarship Deadline

- June 29th, 2018

Scholarship Type

- Merit based

Scholarship Requirements

- Must have a cumulative 2.5 grade point average (GPA)
- Must be in good standing in accordance with the Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) Policy
- Applicants are not required to apply for financial aid; however, students that have submitted a FAFSA must have an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of 3000 or above.
- Must be a US citizen or permanent resident

Required Documentation

- Complete and signed application form; incomplete applications will not be considered.
- One page personal statement addressing applicant's educational goals and how this scholarship will help you achieve those goals.

Selection & Award Process

- Scholarship applications will be reviewed by a committee. The committee may select up to 5 applicants to receive the scholarship and alternate recipients.
- Prior to posting award to each student account for each semester, the office of Student Financial Services (SFS) will verify that all awards comply with the [Over Award policy](#).
- Selected recipients will receive \$500 for the Fall 2018 & \$500 for the Spring 2019 semester.
- Scholarship is non-transferrable to other institutions.

Maintaining Eligibility for Scholarship

- To receive a Spring 2019 award, recipients must:
 - Maintain a cumulative 2.5 grade point average (GPA); recipients must not drop, withdraw, or fail courses to remain eligible.
 - Remain in good standing in accordance with the Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) Policy
 - Enroll in at least 6 credit hours during the Spring 2019 semester
